Our Hope Ministries of Northeast Texas Mission


New Hope Church is blessed to be a “*Hero for Hope*” for Hope Ministries of Northeast Texas. Our relationship with this God-honoring mission began with their becoming a part of our church’s You Matter card project, and as we have learned more about their organization and the help it provides to single adult women and single mothers through God’s infinite grace, we were moved to become more deeply involved.

Judy Capps and her husband Steve started Hope Ministries of Northeast Texas (Hope) in 2013 by responding to God’s calling in their lives. As a tier 2 transitional living facility, Hope provides a faith-based program that seeks to break the cycle of dependency and hopelessness with young single women and their children (in some cases). Instead of merely providing a “hand out”, Hope offers a “Hand Up” to these women by providing them a safe, supportive environment in which to care for themselves and their children, develop social and job skills, continue their education, find employment, and take control of their lives. By enabling these women to develop spiritually while teaching them the life skills needed to move their families out of an often multi-generational state of dependency (on government programs, other people, etc.), they learn how to break the chains of hopelessness and despair. Hope’s active life coaching enables these young people to realize they have a myriad of choices for every situation and prepares them to make faith-driven decisions for their lives—allowing them to walk in the fullness of all God created them to be.

Hope’s vision is; “*To equip women to walk in their God-given destiny through a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.*” This vision is realized through a combination of spiritual, financial, and emotional support as the mission’s participants learn to stand on their own two feet to take their rightful place as independent, productive, self-supporting members of the community.
